\$100, \$200 and \$350 scholarships, as well as travel subsidies (up to ½ cost of airfare) will be available.

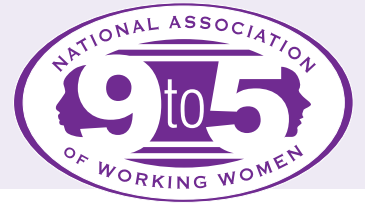

2009 Registration and Scholarship Request Form



Options:

- \$100 scholarship** Recruit 3 new members and submit either **10 signed Voter Postcards** or one completed **Paid Sick Days (PSD) Voices** story.
- \$200 scholarship** Recruit 5 new members (*use the 5 for \$12 each membership drive rate*) and submit either **20 signed Voter Postcards** or **2 PSD Voices** stories.
- \$350 scholarship** Recruit new 10 members (*use the 10 for \$10 each membership drive rate*) and submit **30 signed Voter Postcards** or **3 PSD Voices** stories.

- » **Voter Postcards/ PSD Voices Stories:** Ask your 9to5 staff person for as many "My Voice/My Vote" postcards as you will need. Ask friends, family, co-workers and members of your PTA, block association or congregation to sign and return the cards to you. Request a Voices form from your 9to5 staffperson, to capture the story of someone you know who needed a paid sick day for themselves or a family member.
- » **Voter Postcard alternative:** Local chapters may designate other campaign-related tasks for activities to substitute for voter postcards. Petition signatures or Voices stories related to local policy work may be substituted. Check with your local organizer and to confirm your scholarship requirements.

Travel Subsidy: To qualify you must complete the criteria for the \$200 or the \$350 scholarship.
