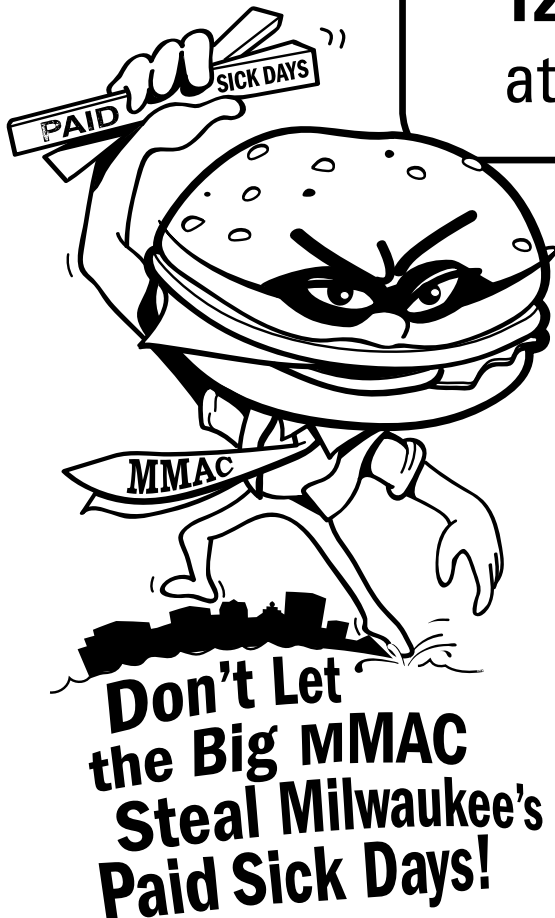


# Join 9to5 and the Paid Sick Day Coalition to tell City Hall that the Judge's Decision Can't Stop Paid Sick Days, Appeal it NOW!

Mayor Barrett, the Common Council, and our City Attorney must stand with the people of this city and its voters. Over 157,000 Milwaukeeans voted for this binding referendum. No city elected official should be siding with MMAC or rewarding their lawsuit against the city.

MMAC lost on almost every point. The sole grounds on which the judge overturned the ordinance was the inclusion of domestic violence and sexual assault, even though many survivors need to take legal action in order to save their lives or their child's life.

Congress is moving paid sick and safe day legislation forward — the Mayor claims to support this federally BUT NOT in his own city.

Wisconsin has the highest reported cases of H1N1 and Milwaukee, is the most infected city in the state. Tell the Mayor, Common Council, and City Attorney, "Don't let the MMAC steal paid sick days! Appeal this decision NOW."
